DATE: Saturday, June 1, 2024

TIME: Lineup is at 9:00 AM; parade will roll at 10:00 AM

THEME: "Just a little peachy lagniappe"

ROUTE: Floats may begin lining up at 9:00 a.m. at Ruston High School. The parade will start promptly at 10:00 a.m. The parade will begin by exiting left from the RHS parking lot, follow Everett Street to West Alabama. Take a left onto West Alabama followed by a left onto North Monroe Street. Follow North Monroe Street to the South Service Road. Take a left onto the South Service Road and then left onto James Street heading back to RHS parking lot. Parade attendees will be encouraged to view the parade on West Alabama and North Monroe Street. Please note, you will be contacted via email before the parade with reminders about line-up, route, and rules.

ENTRY FEE: \$50 per float. Please note that any vehicle pulling any attachment is considered a float.
\$25 for Peach Pageant participants and two-axle cars.
\$10 late fee applied to all applications received after May 24, 2024. No refunds or credits will be issued.

PRIZES: Float competition will be judged for the best design reflecting the parade theme. Prizes will be awarded to first, second, and third place winners.

PARADE RULES & REGULATIONS

VEHICLES & FLOATS:

- ANY VEHICLE PULLING ANY ATTACHMENT IS CONSIDERED A FLOAT.
- A fire extinguisher is required by law on all floats.
- All vehicles/floats must be decorated in the parade theme. If your vehicle or float is not decorated, you will be asked to leave and will not receive a refund.
- No legs hanging over the side of vehicles or floats.
- No train horns!
- Horses, dogs, or any other animals are not permitted to participate in the parade.
- All drivers in the parade must be properly licensed.
- No refunds or credits will be issued.

PARADE SET-UP:

- Line-up begins at 9:00 a.m. Parade will roll at 10:00 a.m.
- Only parade vehicles and floats will be allowed in RHS parking lot.
- Children must always be supervised by an adult with your organization. DO NOT DROP OFF CHILDREN UNATTENDED.
- All decorations, boxes, etc. should be loaded onto the float itself prior to entering the staging area. Decorating may be done in the drop-off/parking area.
- Vehicles which are not in the parade will not be allowed in the staging area.
- The parade may or may not be rescheduled in case of inclement weather conditions.
- Quota USA reserves the right to remove any participant from the parade for any reason.

DURING PARADE

- Vehicles/floats must remain in the parade through the entire procession.
- Participants must always stay inside/on their parade vehicles during procession.
- Absolutely no fireworks or open flames will be allowed.
- Due to causing delays and gaps in the parade, marching bands will be placed at the beginning of the parade.
- No walkers are permitted.

PLEASE BE MINDFUL OF THE MANY LOGISTICS THAT GO INTO ROAD CLOSURES, RE-ROUTING TRAFFIC, AND KEEPING PARADE PARTICIPANTS AND PARADE VIEWERS SAFE. QUOTA USA AND/OR RUSTON POLICE DEPARTMENT WILL REMOVE AND BAN FROM FUTURE PARADE ANY PARTICIPANTS WHO CAUSE DISRUPTION DURING THE PROCESSION.
